

# SAFETY PROTOCOLS FOR HIGH HOLIDAY SERVICES

## Temple Beth Hillel

*Temple Beth Hillel wants to provide a safe environment for congregants and guests who attend in-person High Holiday Services. To do this we need your assistance.*

1. All participants (except children under age 12) must be vaccinated. Children under age 12 must have a negative COVID test within 72 hours before the service.
2. **If you or your guest haven't already done so, please provide proof of your COVID vaccination in advance** to Louise Snitz in one of the following ways:
  - a. Send photo of your vaccine data to her via email ([ltsnitz@gmail.com](mailto:ltsnitz@gmail.com)) or
  - b. Text photo to her at 510-224-0345 or
  - c. Send photo of your vaccine data to L. Snitz, 1202 Evelyn Ave., Berkeley CA 94706. Louise will discard your documentation once she records your vaccine status.
3. If you are planning to attend, please fill out registration form for you and your guests and return to Temple by August 31, 2021.
4. If you are bringing children, please inform Temple at 510-223-2650 or [mhusby@tbhrichmond.org](mailto:mhusby@tbhrichmond.org) at least 5 days in advance. This is so we can plan seating. Children will sit in pods with their parents.
5. All children and adults must wear masks.
6. We will practice social distancing.
7. Services will be presented in the outside patio and entrance will be from the parking lot to the patio. At the entrance, greeters will have a checklist of those who have sent in vaccination verification. If for some reason, you have not sent in the verification, you can show proof at the entrance and we will record your verification. Children will need to show proof of negative COVID test taken within 72 hours of service. **To help ensure an efficient process, please send your verification information in advance. Please be patient as we check people in.**
8. **Please arrive at Temple at least 30 minutes in advance of service to ensure a seat and also to help the Rabbi start services on time.**
